1. Label the seven continents (4 points)

4. Draw a compass rose that includes the four cardinal directions and the four intermediate directions (2 points)

5. Create a map key (3 points)

7. Quality of work (5 points)

- Lightly color the map in color pencil, not markers. Color in one direction and stay within the lines.
- All labels must be written neatly in pen so they are easy to read.
- Capitalize the first letter of proper nouns. Spell words correctly.
