Summary of Slides for Presentation

Title & Presenters	Include a title for your presentation and the names of the presenters .
Overview of Topic	Identify your culture and list some brief, important facts such time period, places, and important people related to your topic.
Geography	Describe the land where your civilization lived. Include at least one <u>student created map</u> showing the location of important features such as mountains, bodies of water, rivers and cities.
Characteristics of Civilization	Create at least three slides that relate to three of the seven characteristics of a civilization. Include at least <u>three</u> specific details about that characteristic. Include at least one <u>student created</u> drawings of an important artifact .
Legacy	What contributions did your culture give to the modern world – why do we remember them, how have they influenced the course of history?
Bibliography	Include at least three sources in the proper format as your final slide. Use the bibliography worksheet provided.

Presentation Grade

_____ / **10 Points - Slide Organization and General Content:** content of slides and ordering must follow the summary written on page one of this packet. Include at least two images or other objects in your slideshow. This could include clip art, pictures found on the web, animations, sounds, etc. All images/objects must relate directly to your topic.

_____ / **5 Points - Slides Printed Out:** turn in one printed copy of your slide show on the day of your presentation. Print out the slide show in handout form to save ink and paper.

_____ / **20 Points - Ideas and Content:** information must be factual and reflect thorough and thoughtful research done by your group. Include information about geography, legacy and at least three of the seven characteristics of a civilization. Important vocabulary terms or ideas must be defined.

Includes the following content slides:

- Title/names
- Overview (brief facts)
- Geography (at least one student-made map)
- Characteristics (at least three slides, at least one student-made artifact)
- Legacy (connection to modern world)
- Bibliography (three sources)

_____ / **10 Points - Effective Visual Design:** slides must use a consistent design theme. Colors and fonts should be thoughtfully chosen and animation used effectively. Design elements should enhance, not distract from, the information. Each slide must be carefully proofread for correct spelling and grammar.

_____ / **5 Points - Length of Presentation:** between two to five minutes long (no long pauses or slow animation). You will lose 1 point for each minute your presentation is over or below the time limit.

_____ / **10 Points - Presentation Skills:** Everyone must participate in the presentation. Speak loud enough for all to hear, make eye contact consistently (face the audience, not the screen), and speak clearly and fluidly (no mumbled words, long pauses, or fillers). Do not read information word for word from the screen. The person running the slideshow should be skilled at moving between slides.

_____ / **10 Points Group Involvement:** each group member should have equal involvement in the project. This includes the amount of time speaking during the presentation and how much each person contributes to the project. Take equal turns sitting at the computer while creating the presentation.
