Who can host?

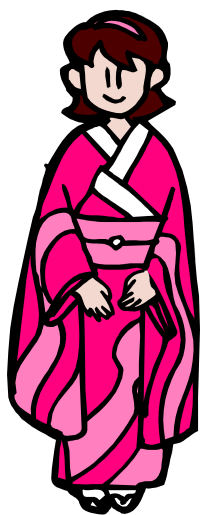
- Hosting an exchange student can be a satisfying experience for people from all walks of life and with a variety of family situations!

- Room and board (*Students can share a room with a host sibling of the same gender, but must have a separate bed)
- Transportation to/from school (school bus transportation may also be arranged)

Host Families Receive:

- The opportunity to make lasting friendships and learn about another culture
- An international experience - without ever leaving home!
- The chance to make a difference in an exchange student's life
- Comprehensive support and assistance from Program Coordinators throughout the program.
- \$10 per student, per night to help offset the costs of hosting. *This per diem can also be donated to the school!
